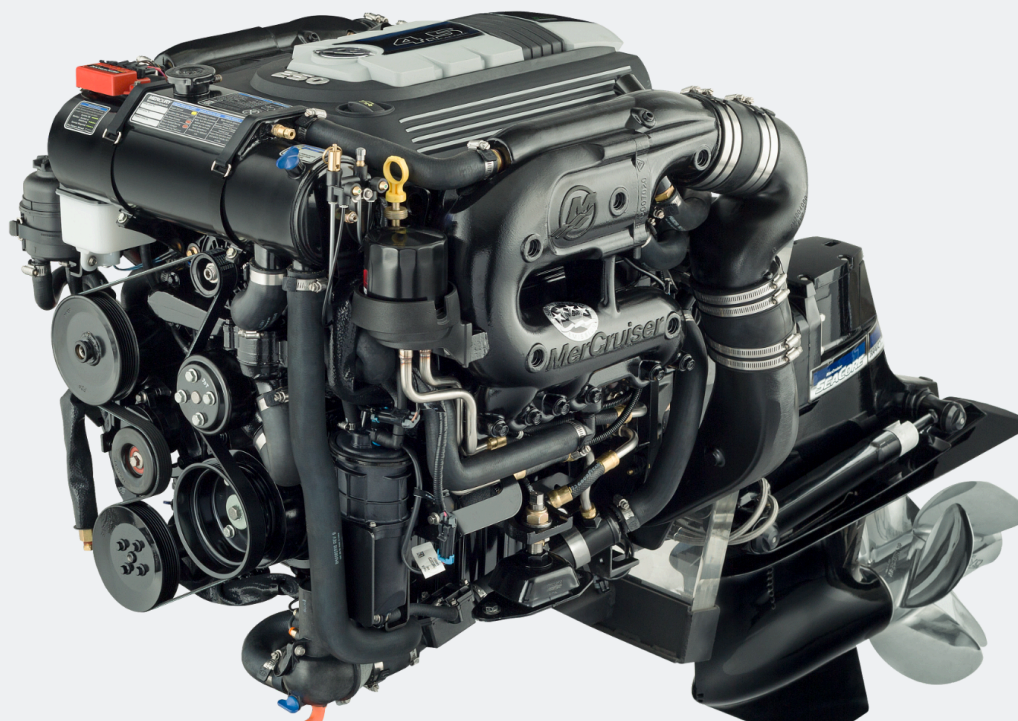

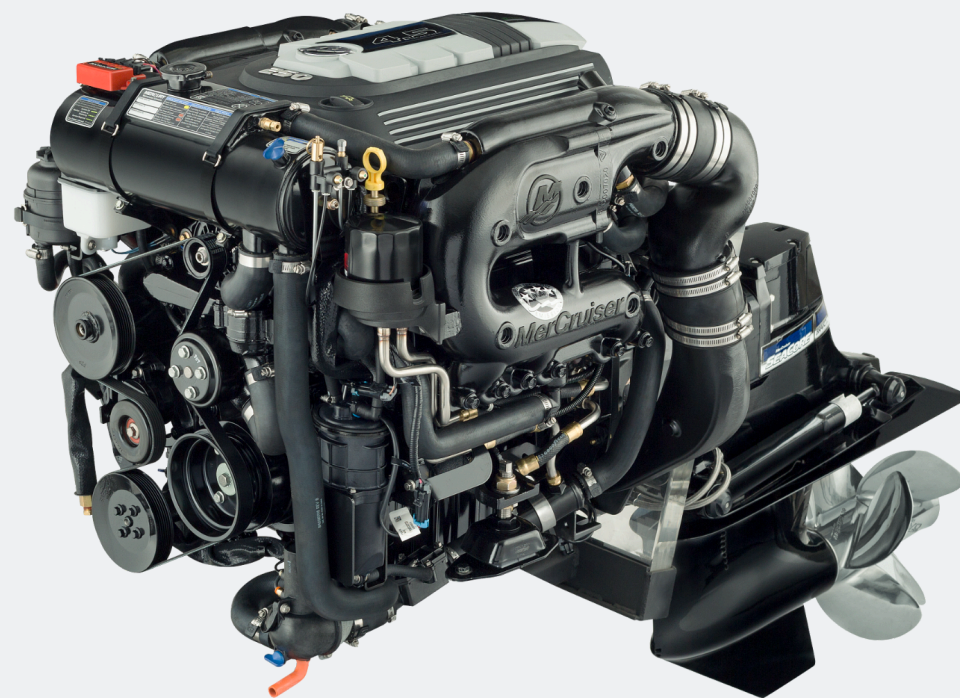

A SeaCore version with a closed cooling system is available upon request.

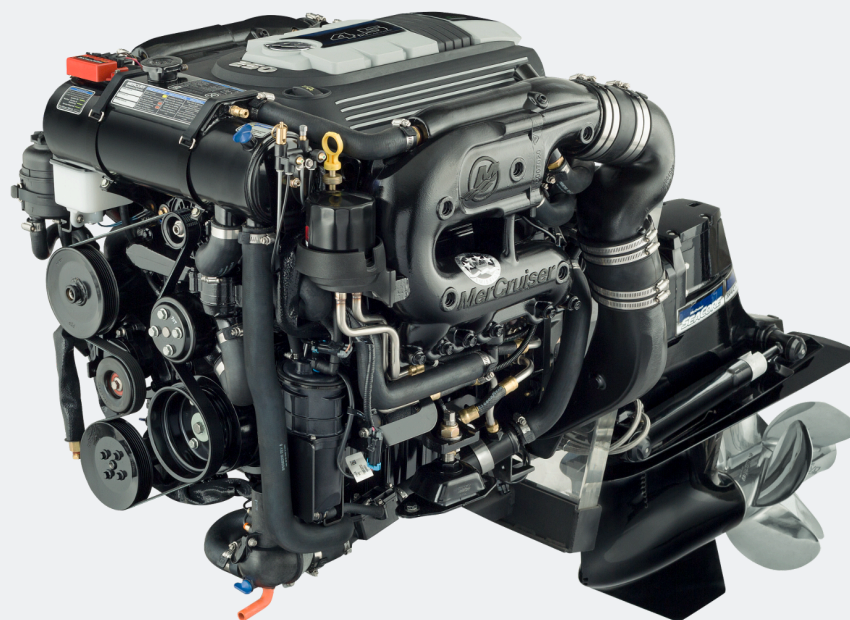
